Science or Mathematics <i>For the AS degree it must be higher than MT150. The AS degree must include a total of at least 4 credit hours in MA, MT, STA or ST courses from the approved general education list (see reverse, this excludes MT105, MT110, MT115 and MT 120).</i>	3 3 (4)		

- ❖ AA and AS degrees are awarded to students who complete a minimum of 60 hours, including the specified general education requirements, with a GPA of at least 2.0.
- ❖ A course used to fulfill one competency cannot be used to fulfill another competency. Developmental/remedial courses (courses numbered 001-099) cannot be used to satisfy graduation requirements.
- ❖ Regardless of the time the student has attended the college, a minimum of 24 credits must be completed within the KCTCS colleges and at least 25% of the approved curriculum credits must be completed at the college granting the degree.
- ❖ **REVISION**-Students graduating fall 2009 or later must complete only 15 credit hours of the degree at the college granting the degree.
