

Web Developer and Administrator Certificates

This program is designed for persons currently in the workforce who desire to upgrade their skills or acquire new skills in the fields of web development and administration. Upon completion of the certificate the graduate will be qualified to take industry designed and recognized certification examinations. Employment opportunities include entry-level positions to develop, implement, manage and maintain web sites.

This workforce certificate program assumes that students entering this program possess math and writing skills necessary for the program's course-work. Students entering the program will take a placement test, and may be required to take developmental course-work in the areas if indicated by the placement tests.

Students entering this program will need to have basic computer skills such as would be obtained through the CIS 100 course (Introduction to Computers) or equivalent.
