

## College Name Selection Process

### *An Overview*

- Appointment of a College Name Selection Committee** **January 2004**  
*Request for volunteers to serve on the Committee was made at the District-wide Consolidation Conference in January 2004. The Committee, chaired by Lisa Brosky, included individuals from both Colleges: Lisa Brosky (JCC), Alice Cleveland (JCC), Rebecca Hellemans (JCC), Dennis Lawrey (JTC), Mel Tabor (JCC), Karla Hall (JCC), Bob Sillman (JTC), John Wieland (Shelby), Ron Walford (JCC), Carol Duncan (JTC), Larry Maddox (JTC)*
- Call for Proposed Names Issued to the College Community** **January 2004**  
*A district-wide e-mail was sent requesting suggestions of proposed names for the consolidated institution. A total of 352 responses were received.*
- Review of Proposed Names (352 Responses) by the College Name Selection Committee** **February 2004**  
*The Name Selection Committee reviewed the responses and selected the top five choices which met KCTCS guidelines. The proposed names were:*  
*Jefferson Community and Technical College*  
*Thomas Jefferson Community and Technical College*  
*Kentuckiana Community and Technical College*  
*Jefferson Metro Community and Technical College*  
*Bluegrass Community and Technical College.*
- Polling of the College Community to Determine Preferences Among the Top Five Proposed Names Meeting KCTCS Guidelines** **February 2004**  
*The results of the preference poll were:*  
208 *Jefferson Community and Technical College*  
37 *Thomas Jefferson Community and Technical College*  
26 *Kentuckiana Community and Technical College*  
21 *Jefferson Metro Community and Technical College*  
19 *Bluegrass Community and Technical College.*
- Submission of Three Possible College Names by the College Name Selection Committee to the JCC Board of Directors and the JTC Advisory Board** **March 2004**  
*Based on the results of the preference poll, the Name Selection Committee forwarded the top three proposed names to the JCC Board of Directors and the JTC Advisory Board with a strong recommendation for the proposed name of “Jefferson Community and Technical College.”*
