INSTRUCTIONS TO ROOM & BOARD SPONSOR

THINGS THE SPONSOR SHOULD KNOW

A sponsor may be a student applicant's family member, friend, a religious organization or any other agency. The Affidavit of Sponsor Providing Room and Board is a statement made by the sponsor that assures the United States government and Jefferson Community and Technical College that the student applicant will not become a public charge in the United States and will not become destitute while studying at JCTC.

By submitting a signed affidavit, the sponsor has promised to provide the student applicant with yearly financial support specified in the affidavit. The sponsor also has promised that all documents of evidence of income and resources are true, correct, and verifiable.

The sponsor must understand that the affidavit is binding for each year the student applicant attends JCTC unless the student applicant submits a new Affidavit of Sponsor Providing Room and Board from a different sponsor.

SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

The Affidavit of Sponsor Providing Room and Board is complete ONLY if the following information is attached:

- **A copy of the sponsor's lease agreement or proof of homeownership, and**
- **An original employment verification letter from the sponsor's employer:** This statement must be on company stationery, verify that the sponsor is employed, and include the following information:
 - The sponsor's name and local address, and
 - The date of hire and nature of employment.

If the sponsor is self-employed, the sponsor must submit a copy of his or her most recent filed income tax form, or a report of commercial rating concern.

ESTIMATED EXPENSES

The following is a detailed description of Jefferson Community and Technical College's estimation of the cost of tuition and living for the academic year of 2009 to 2010. Charges can change at any time.
